

OBTAIN 2012 DOG LICENSES BY MARCH 1, 2012

Chapter 40 of the Pittsgrove Township Code requires that any dog over the age of six months shall be inoculated against rabies and licensed by its owner. Dog licenses must be obtained on or before March 1 each year. **Late fees will be imposed starting on Friday, March 2 upon owners who fail to obtain licenses timely. Exceptions cannot be made, regardless of situation or circumstances.**

To License Your Dog(s) By Mail: (One form per dog, please. Photocopies are acceptable.) Complete and mail the form below, together with the dog's **current** rabies certificate, proof of sterilization (spay/neuter), appropriate fee and a **stamped, self-addressed, full size envelope** to: Township of Pittsgrove, Office of the Township Clerk, 989 Centerton Road, Pittsgrove, NJ 08318. The rabies certificate will be returned to you with the 2012 Dog License and tag.

Pursuant to NJAC 8:23A-4.1 the rabies immunity must extend throughout at least ten of the twelve month licensing period. If the immunity against rabies expires prior to the tenth month of the licensing period revaccination shall occur prior to licensure---meaning the Rabies vaccination cannot expire before November 1, 2012. If vaccination does expire, the dog needs to get re-vaccinated in order to renew the license.

To License Your Dog(s) In-Person:
Go to the Office of the Township Clerk in the Municipal Building, 989 Centerton Road, Pittsgrove, NJ between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., with the dog's **current** rabies certificate, proof of sterilization (spay/neuter) and appropriate fee.
