 - Willow Grove Lake – A meeting of local residents and Freeholder Hogan and Mayor Voros was held on 9-30-09 at the Willow Grove Methodist Community Hall.
A judge's decision is to be made on 10-26-09 on shared responsibilities for repairing the spillway.
