AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 72, SECTION 72-5A OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PITTS GROVE

WHEREAS, Chapter 72 of the Code of the Township of Pittsgrove entitled, "Parks and Recreation Areas" involves legislation related to Township parks, streams, lakes and recreational areas (hereinafter "Parks"); and

WHEREAS, on February 10, 2009, Section 72-5A was added to Chapter 72 of the Code to set forth, among other things, the operating hours of Parks and Recreation Facilities; and

WHEREAS, the revision mistakenly indicated that the Parks and Recreation Facilities would be available to all members of the public from "Dusk to Dawn"; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to make a correction to the ordinance to reflect the correct operating hours of Parks and Recreation Facilities.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Pittsgrove that the following amendment shall be made to Chapter 72, Section 72-5A, which shall state:

A. Pittsgrove Township Public Parks & Recreation Facilities are for the use and benefit of the general public and shall remain accessible to all members of the public from **dawn to dusk**, unless otherwise reserved and approved by the Pittsgrove Township Recreation Committee and Pittsgrove Township Committee, or otherwise set forth in this Ordinance. All such use shall be in accordance with all applicable state, county and local laws and ordinances.

This Ordinance shall take effect according to law. All other ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
