The Salem County Engineer's Office is hosting a "Public Information Center" on Tuesday, September 21, 2010. The Center will give citizens the opportunity to offer comments on the ALMOND ROAD, COUNTY ROAD #540, RESURFACING PROJECT located within Pittsgrove Township. The project limits for Phase I are from Centerton Road, County Road #553 to Parvins Mill Road, County Road #645 and the project limits for Phase II are from Parvins Mill Road, County Road #645 to the Salem County/Cumberland County Line.

The purpose of this Public Information Center is to inform local residents, Officials and the business community of Salem County's proposed plans for improvements to Almond Road, County Road #540 in Pittsgrove Township. The project will improve Almond Road, County Road #540 by resurfacing the roadway, improving the riding surface of the roadway, upgrading signing and striping, and upgrading guide-rail were warranted. You are encouraged to actively participate by attending and providing comments. Design plans and other exhibits will be displayed for your review. Representatives from Salem County and the designer will be present to answer your questions.

We are hosting this "Public Information Center" as part of the project's public comment period, which lasts until October 12, 2010. Citizens have three (3) ways to provide comment during the public comment period:

- Written comment at the Public Information Center; or
