BOND ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR VARIOUS CAPITOL IMPROVEMENTS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PITTSBORO, IN THE COUNTY OF SALEM, NEW JERSEY, APPROPRIATING THE AGGREGATE AMOUNT OF \$156,000 THEREFOR AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$148,000 BONDS OR NOTES OF THE TOWNSHIP TO FINANCE PART OF THE COST THEREOF
