PLASTIC BOTTLES & JARS

Only plastic bottles and jars with a number or on the bottom



DO NOT RECYCLE



NO hardback books, foil-coated or food contaminated boxes.



NO plastic pails, trays, tubs, food containers or foil items



NO motor oil, lubricants, paint and pesticide containers



NO mugs, glasses, vases, bulbs, bakeware, dishes, & window glass



NO refrigerated or frozen containers



NO plastic bags, styrofoam, lids or caps

CLEAN COMMUNITIES MINI-GRANT PROGRAM GUIDELINES

MINI-GRANT AWARDS

- \$300.00 for each completed assignment.
- Eligible for Non Profit Organizations only

GROUP OBLIGATIONS

A minimum of twelve (12) members is required to start a Mini-Grant assignment. Smaller groups require approval by the Clean Communities Coordinator. Each group must provide at least one (1) adult supervisor for every eight (8) youth workers under age 17.

ASSIGNMENT CONTROL

Assignments will be selected by the Clean Communities Coordinator and may consist of roadways or park areas or a combination of both.

Clean-up materials, including trash bags, gloves, signs, and safety vests will be provided by the Clean Communities Coordinator. These items will be available for pick-up by the Group's representative at the Township Municipal building within one (1) week prior to the assignment date. Reusable materials and safety clothing must be returned to the Clean Communities Coordinator upon completion of the assignment.

PERFORMANCE

Each group is responsible for disposing of all litter and recyclable materials at the Township Waste Facility. Recyclable materials must be sorted and deposited in the designated containers at the Waste Facility. All recyclable materials collected by Clean Communities Mini-Grant groups are the property of Pittsgrove Township.

Each group is required to complete a report containing the amount of the assignment that has been cleaned and the amount of the litter and recyclables (by type) that has been picked-up.

White goods (refrigerators, ranges, hot water tanks, etc.) shall be reported on the Weight Report only. The Clean

Communities Coordinator will arrange for pick-up by the Township Public Works Department.

SCHEDULES

All groups are required to complete assignments on the day scheduled. Starting on one day and finishing on another day is not permitted. If a group has an insufficient number of persons or time to complete their assignment on the scheduled day, the assignment will need to be rescheduled.

Requests for schedule changes must be submitted to the Clean Communities Coordinator prior to the start of their assignment.

Any group who does not show up for their assignment and has not notified the Clean Communities Coordinator in advance will have their assignment cancelled. No reschedule will be given and no payment will be made.

LIABILITY

All groups are recommended to carry liability insurance with medical coverage for their members. Group representatives will be required to sign a statement of release to the State of New Jersey and the Township of Pittsgrove of any and all liability resulting from the accomplishment of a Clean Communities Mini-Grant assignment.

PAYMENT

Payment of the \$300.00 dollar Mini-Grant will be made for a fully completed assignment only. No payment will be made for a partially completed assignment. No Payment will be made if clean-up materials and Weight Report form have not been returned to the Clean Communities Coordinator upon completion of the assignment.

PITTSGROVE RECYCLABLES INFORMATION

ALL RESIDENTS AND PROPERTY OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR COMPLIANCE WITH THE MANDATORY RECYCLING PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS.

MANDATORY RECYCLABLES:

The following materials must be disposed of as recyclable materials, rather than waste, and shall be disposed of in designated containers.

- COMINGLE: (in same container) plastic and glass bottles (all colors), steel, tin, and aluminum cans. Rinse all containers and remove caps, rings, or bands.
- CORRUGATED (CARDBOARD): Clean corrugated or cardboard containers. Includes brown paper bags.
- PAPER: Newspapers and inserts, magazines, books, junk mail, and office/copier/computer paper.
- SCRAP METAL: Tire rims, springs, bicycles, etc.

- NOTE: Please see the list of Prohibited Materials

ADDITIONAL RECYCLABLE MATERIALS:

- BATTERIES: Lead Acid (cars, trucks etc.); Household (AA, C cell); Rechargeable (NiCad, NiMH, Lithium Ion)
- COMPUTER MONITORS (small disposal fee applies)
- BRUSH/TREE PARTS: from residential sources.
 - EXCLUDED: Brush from clearing operations and tree limbs over three (3) inches in diameter or eight (8) feet long.
- GRASS CLIPPINGS: from mowing lawns.
- LEAVES: Tree leaves only.
 - NOTE: Residents/property owners/occupants are encouraged to mulch or compost leaves at their sites.
- CONCRETE: Including cement and cinderblock. Limited to one (1) pick-up truckload, up to 500 lbs or 2 cubic yards, per homeowner project.

G. USED MOTOR OIL: Petroleum based or synthetic. Containers of 5 gallons or less for ease of handling. Oil shall be protected from contamination by rainwater.

H. WHITE GOODS: Appliances (washers, dryers, ranges, water heaters etc.) Also see the following item.

- THERE IS A DISPOSAL FEE FOR THE FOLLOWING:
PROPANE TANKS; all refrigerators, freezers and air conditioners; computer monitors; Tires (rubber-based automotive, truck or specialty tires)

PROHIBITED MATERIALS:

THE PITTSGROVE TOWNSHIP WASTE DISPOSAL FACILITY ATTENDANT IS AUTHORIZED TO REJECT ANY ITEM CONSISTING OF OR CONTAINING THE FOLLOWING MATERIALS:

- Animal carcasses.
- Automobiles, tractors, farm machinery, trailers and trucks or parts of any of these vehicles.
- Herbicide, pesticide and chemical containers, unless triple rinsed and certified to be non-hazardous.
- Non-household chemical or petroleum products.
- Gasoline fuel tanks, gasoline containers and cans, and fuel tanks for kerosene heaters and oil filled radiator type heaters.
- Tree stumps.
- Oil based paints.
- Waste materials resulting from construction, repair, alteration, renovation or demolition by contractors, residents or property owners.
- Waste materials generated outside of the Township.
