NOTICE OF PENDING ORDINANCE AND SUMMARY

This ordinance, the summary of which is included herein, was introduced and passed on first reading at a Regular Meeting of the Township Committee of the Township of Pittsgrove in the County of Salem, State of New Jersey on Wednesday, January 27, 2021. **AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PITTSGROVE TO AMEND SECTION
60-42(X) OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE REGARDING STORMWATER CONTROL**

“This ordinance amends and replaces Section 60-42(X) of the Township Code of the Township of Pittsgrove which is Pittsgrove Township's Stormwater Control Ordinance. Amendments to New Jersey's Stormwater Management rules at N.J.A.C. 7:8 were proposed by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (“NJDEP”). These proposed rules were adopted on March 2, 2020. In accordance with Pittsgrove Township's New Jersey Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NJPDES) Permit, NJDEP is requiring Pittsgrove Township to revise its Stormwater Control Ordinance to conform with these amended rules. This ordinance is a form of NJDEP's model ordinance to bring Pittsgrove Township's Stormwater Control Ordinance into compliance with these new rules.”
