

1. Recreation – Spring & Fall 2022

a. Start Dates

- i. Spring: March 21, 2022
- ii. Fall: Sept 19, 2022

b. End Dates

- i. Spring: Jun 4, 2022
- ii. Fall: Nov 19, 2022

c. Fields

- i. Spring: Fields 4, 5, 6, 7, 13, 16, and 18. Pittsgrove Day field (18) is normally used for u3-u8. We will make other arrangements for games on the day of the event.
- ii. Fall: Same fields as Spring.

Note: Game fields for Recreation have to be centered around the concession stand to best accommodate Club HQ activities. Also exact field locations will be decided before the season based on field conditions. Some fields may need to be rested.

d. Concession

- i. Concession stand for all recreation game days, Saturdays 8:00am-1:30pm and possibly during the week for some evening games and practices 5-9 pm.

e. Pavilion use for season-ending picnics

- i. Spring: Pavilion 8-2pm on May 21st.
- ii. Fall: Pavilion 8-2pm on November 5th for picnic.

f. Bathroom

- i. For use during Rec

g. Lights (included here for completeness, request with Public Works)

- i. Spring: Use of portable lights (4 total) on fields as needed.
- ii. Fall: Use of portable lights (4 total) on fields as needed.

- iii. Any teams practicing with sufficient daylight will not use fields 10, 11, 12 to reduce wear and tear on the fields unless necessary due to insufficient light. Final details for fields will be discussed between soccer and Public Works Foreman .

2. Travel Soccer – Spring & Fall 2022

a. Start Dates

- i. Spring: Feb, 21, 2022 - weather permitting.
- ii. Fall: August 15, 2022

b. End Dates

- i. The regular season league games typically end one week before Memorial Day in Spring and one week before Thanksgiving in Fall. These dates vary depending on make-up games from rainouts/cancellations. Some teams continue to play after a season is completed for tournament preparation. Public Works Foreman will be notified when all teams are finished using the fields.

c. Fields

i. Game Fields

- 1. 7, 13, 14, 15, and 17 (rotated as necessary). [Note: There are 3 distinct sizes required depending on age group.]

ii. Practice fields

- 1. 4, 5, 6, 10, 11, 12, 21 Note: We may need portable lights on fields depending on team demand. ***Final details for fields will be discussed between soccer and Public Works Foreman.***

Note: Our goal is to move practice off 10, 11, 12 and game fields as daylight permits. The more fields we use the less potential damage to them.

- 2. *Goals on practice fields will be placed to reduce wear and tear on the goal mouths of the fields. This will vary from time to time based on the need to go full field for a practice.*

- 3. Summer/Winter

Pittsgrove Soccer Club

1. Use of three fields (least in need of rest) for teams competing in tournaments during the winter and summer months (pickup games) as well as summer camps. Will be determined based on field conditions.

d. Concession Stand

- i. Concession stand will be used for all EDP tournaments during the year except on dates 5/28, 5/29, 6/11, and 6/12 (Football will use it on these days).

e. Lights

- i. Use of lights on 10, 11, 12 and portable lights on various other fields between 5pm to 9pm as needed.
- ii. Lighted fields will not be used when daylight permits.
- iii. Will coordinate use of portable lights with Public Works Foreman.

3. PSC Labor Day Tournament

a. Tournament Weekend

- i. September 3rd and 4th - PSC Labor Day Tournament

b. Fields

- i. The number of fields for the tournament depends on the number of teams, but typically all fields will be utilized. Football fields will be the last utilized.

c. Goals

- i. Need to be on fields two days before tournaments.

d. Concession

- i. Concession stand will be used by PSC personnel during tournaments.

e. Bathroom

- i. Key for bathrooms

- ii. Will be cleaned when finished
- f. Cart Storage
 - i. Golf Carts will need to be stored in the pole barn overnight. Will arrange details with Public Works Foreman.
- g. Tent
 - i. Large tent if necessary (if potential for rain).
- h. Barriers & Parking Signs
 - i. Use of township barriers and signs to reduce parking on grass and in unauthorized areas.
- i. Propane Grill Cooking
 - i. Use of propane grills in designated areas.
 - ii. Approved by Fire Marshall prior to event and/or season.
- j. Vendors
 - i. PSC will use various vendors for food, entertainment, and apparel.
 - ii. *PSC will inform all vendors of their licensing responsibilities. This information will be sent to the township and county for confirmation that the vendors meet the county health department codes.*
