- A. Meeting Called to Order at 7:30 by Tim Hack.
- B. Pledge of Allegiance

- E. Harry made a motion to approve the minutes from the April 4th meeting. Tim seconded the motion. All approved.
- F. Old Business
 - a. Member Update- we have three new/returning members: Bruce Ricards, Jodi Mavroff, and Lori Young.
- G. New Business
 - a. Pittsgrove Day
 - i. Recognizing Sponsors and schedule signs- we need to see what we have from prior years and purchase others. For digital advertising- a separate flyer will be made by Meghan. Cheryl is ordering signs and banners
 - ii. Vendor Updates- Jodi will contact Tim Hunt. Meg will email the link to anyone searching for more food vendors. Soft pretzels and soda need to be added to the list of what the ladies' auxiliary is selling. There is no specific deadline for the Health Dept- they just need enough time to contact the business and make sure licensing is solid. Harry asked if football and Soccer need a tent. He said they can share 20 x 30 by walking path. Meghan will check with them and also check with horse people about making sure the horse poop is cleaned up.
 - iii. The stage is scheduled to be set up. Bands are scheduled. Opening Ceremony, other entertainment. Need someone to sing the national anthem.
 - iv. 5K and bike parade- Meghan will ask Andre if they are bringing signs to mark the course or if we need signs

- v. Hot Air Balloon rides-75 foot tether. Our contact is Charlie Blair. We pay him a fee and then he charges \$20 per person/per ride.
 - vi. American Bounce- Harry will contact them to check on inflatables, an arena for bumper balls, and to clarify the pricing of wristbands so we can inform residents
 - vii. Bumper Bubbles and Hardest Soccer Kick will be run by different soccer teams and in the area near bouncy houses.
 - viii. Cornhole tournament- it has been advertised on Facebook
 - ix. Tractor and Antique Car Show: instead of using the playground parking lot cars will line the main drag of Greenbranch
 - x. Police- we need to supply cones- we need to contact Salem Corrections and Chris McNeill (State Police) to discuss traffic control
 - xi. Meghan will reach out to the high school about the art students having a tent
 - xii. Lori suggested a QR code link to the day's schedule be created and made available to residents.
 - xiii. Basket for Auction- Cheryl collected money from members to contribute to a gift card basket for the Basket Auction on Pittsgrove Day. The time will be 6:30 for picking numbers for basket raffle winners.
 - xiv. Shirts- Cheryl is going to look into other quotes. The one she received was very expensive per shirt.
- H. Chuck Hughes reported that the concession stand roof will be finished before Pittsgrove day. After Pittsgrove Day, 49 dead trees along split rails will be removed and the Irrigation pump motor will be removed and taken out for investigation. He also reported that committee member Fran Spinelli is leading the effort to have the woods at Greenbranch cleared of underbrush and likely a control burn plan will be put in place in the future.
